

Dev. Basketball Tournament Rules

Grades 3&4



This tournament has been created to increase the focus on skill development and mirror ORYA's current approach to the 3rd and 4th grades. Players should focus on proper technique and have high rates of success early in their basketball experience. By playing 3v3 on 8 foot hoops players get increased time with the ball and many more opportunities to be successful on the court. With a lower rim, players don't have to muscle the ball to get it high enough. They are able to focus on proper form over power generation.

Quality of individual and team play should be considered the judgement of success, even within a game format. We hope you enjoy this event and can cheer for quality of play from both sides of the court!

ORYA TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND RULES FOR 3RD-4TH GRADE TEAMS:

- 3v3 Game format
- 8 ft. hoops will be utilized
- 2- 11 minute halves
 - 2 minutes for half time
- No full court press until the final 2 minutes of each quarter
- No full court press if up by 10 points or more
- Will shoot free throws from a 12 ft. line
 - 1 free throw at 2 points
- Substitutes will be the same as in stop-time play

Team Recommendations and Requirements

- We recommend 4-7 players per team
- Players may not double rosters and can only play on one team throughout the tournament
- Team rosters must be presented to the scorer's table prior to each tournament game
- First team listed is home team and wears white

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of his/her players, other coaches and fans associated with their team as well as his/her own behavior. If proper behavior is not exhibited it could result in forfeiture and expulsion from the tournament. It could also affect participation in the tournament in future years.
