#### Program Descriptions |

Fall baseball is a relaxed offering for older players that want to continue playing in the off-season. The team will participate in the Seacoast Fall Baseball League with league information found <u>HERE</u>. While participating in a middle school division classified as grades 6-8 ORYA will only offer this to those entering or returning to Babe Ruth and the 90 ft base path in the spring 2019 season. Those players are primarily in grades 7&8.

We currently have one head-coach identified so if enough players register to warrant multiple teams we will need to identify a second head coach out of the parent pool.

ORYA will need to reach a 12 player threshold to make this team successful at the budgeted player tuition. If less than 12 players participate, ORYA may be required to request additional player fees to cover program expenses or cancel the program.

#### Schedule |

On field practices will take place on Mondays at Little River Park in Lee. Since we know most players will be participating in traditional fall sports the Wednesday sessions will be held at the Demerritt cage to get some reps for players available to make the sessions. Games are scheduled per the league and as outlined on their site.

## Team Snap

Your volunteer coach(es) will utilize Team Snap to communicate with you this fall. This easy & userfriendly app helps keep your schedule straight and allows to and from communications with your coach. Great for last minute schedule updates and player availability, we hope this app makes your season that much easier to keep track of!

# Uniform |

Players will utilize current ORYA Babe Ruth uniforms in stock. They will be issued at the first practice and returned at the end of the final team meeting. Each player will need to purchase a hat for the season but if they played ORYA Babe Ruth in the 2018 season you will not need to purchase another one. Players will also need to utilize their own pants and can wear either grey or white pants. Hats will be ordered after the registration deadline to ensure we officially have a team prior to placing an order.

## Player Tuition |

The tuition for this program accounts for insurance (medical & liability), ORYA Admin fee of \$35 and Capital Fund of \$12.50, online payment processing fees, field-based sport per-player field maintenance fee, SFBL fee, per game umpire fees, equipment budget (baseballs), budget for coach background checks, safe sport certifications and Team Snap dues.
