Program Description |

All players will participate in an appropriate team warmup. Players will then be split into age level groups and take part in football station drills with the goal of developing and improving skills such as throwing, catching, defending, etc. Following skills drills, players will be split into 2 or more teams, based on parity, and participate in intracamp flag football games for the remainder of the day.

What to Bring |

Each participant should bring sneakers, cleats if desired (no metal tips), clothes appropriate for the weather, sunblock, a small healthy snack, a full water bottle, and any other equipment they would normally bring to a flag football practice.

Please have sneakers, even if your player normally wears cleats, in the event of poor weather. If the weather is poor, they will utilize Moharimet gym and cleats are absolutely not allowed.
