### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION |

ORYA’s Summer Sandlot League starts the week after the regular baseball season ends and was designed to provide baseball and fun for the current Majors Baseball players that want to play more ball but may not want to commit to the time, schedule, cost, and competitiveness of a tournament schedule. The camp will be comprised of two or three games a week with the focus on fun, development, and friendly competition.

### WHAT TO BRING |

Each participant should bring their glove, helmet, personal bat if desired, clothes appropriate for the weather, sunblock, a small healthy snack, a full water bottle and any other equipment they would normally bring to a baseball practice or game.

Please also have regular sneakers in the event of poor weather. If the weather is poor they will seek shelter where cleats are not allowed.

### COMMUNICATIONS |

Coaches will utilize TeamSnap as their messaging tool. TeamSnap is a great way to get quick updates on changes to the regular schedule. This is of the utmost importance as we cannot control things like weather throughout the duration of the camp and may need to make last minute location changes to the calendar.

Coaches will be many of those of the regular baseball season. All of our coaches have been background checked, gone through SafeSport training, and are Cal Ripken certified. These coaches have dedicated time to get players extra baseball this summer!

## **PLAYER TUITION |**
