



2020 ORYA All-Star Baseball

Oyster River Cal Ripken Baseball All-Star Baseball is an opportunity for skilled players to play with teammates and against competition with similar skills. Additionally, this is an opportunity to earn their spot on the team allowing them to represent their community in competitive, well-run tournaments.

Roster Size:

- Minimum – 12
- Maximum – 16

Coaches (coach identification process begins immediately):

- Head Coach – 1
- Assistant Coaches – 3
- All Coaches must be Cal Ripken Certified and have coached within the ORYA Baseball Program during the Spring 2020 season.

Parents Baseball Meeting:

- When - April 5th @ 6:30pm (Locations TBD)
- 1-hour parent's session to discuss the 2020 All-Star Season, inclusive of an overview of the schedule, goals for the players, practice/playing time, coaches introduction, etc.

All Star Evaluations

- When - Sunday, May 17th
- 8U/9U @ 10am
- 10U/11U @ 11:30am
- 12U @ 12pm

All Star Evaluations Process

- All players wishing to participate in All-Star baseball must attend the evaluations unless a waiver is granted by the ORYA Baseball Advisory Group. Waiver can only be for medical reasons (e.g. an injury), travel commitments, or conflict with a travel club game.
- Teams will be formed by the Head Coach, Assistant Coaches, and All-Star Baseball Coordinator, as a representative for the ORYA Advisory Group.
- Players extended invitations will be invited to their proper age-designated team (e.g. a baseball 9 will be invited to play on the 9U team)
 - Exceptions to this rule will only be in the following instances:
 - The player has demonstrable skills that necessitate them “playing up” from a player safety perspective
 - The player has shown the demonstrable skill to “play up **AND** there is a need in order to create a full, rostered team at another age level
- To be eligible, all players must play in 51 percent of their designated ORYA baseball team games

Key Details:

- Acceptance/Decline due Friday, May 22
- Evaluations Criteria: Batting, Fielding, Catching, and Pitching
 - 10-point scale for each station
- Practice begins the week of May 24
